UBENWA

An algorithm deployed as a mobile app which uses a smartphone to provide a quick assessment of whether or not a newborn has or is at risk of asphyxia.



DRBRIDGE

A mobile application that helps doctors follow up with patients & deliver care plans through text messaging & email.



FLARE

A mobile app that aggregates available ambulances in Nairobi & allows consumers to request an ambulance.



MPEDIGREE

A technology platform that secures medical products against faking, counterfeiting & diversion.

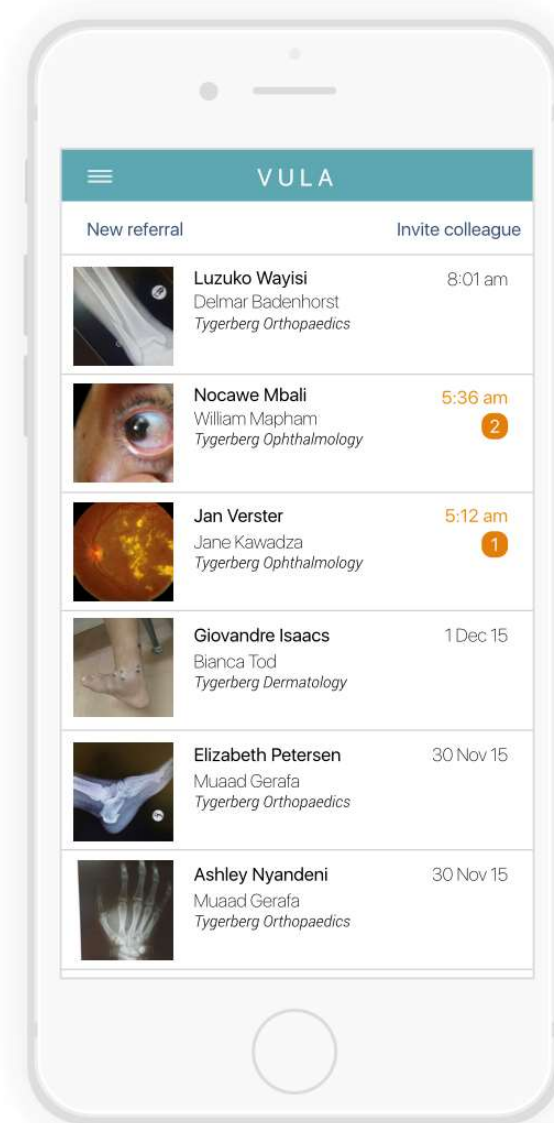

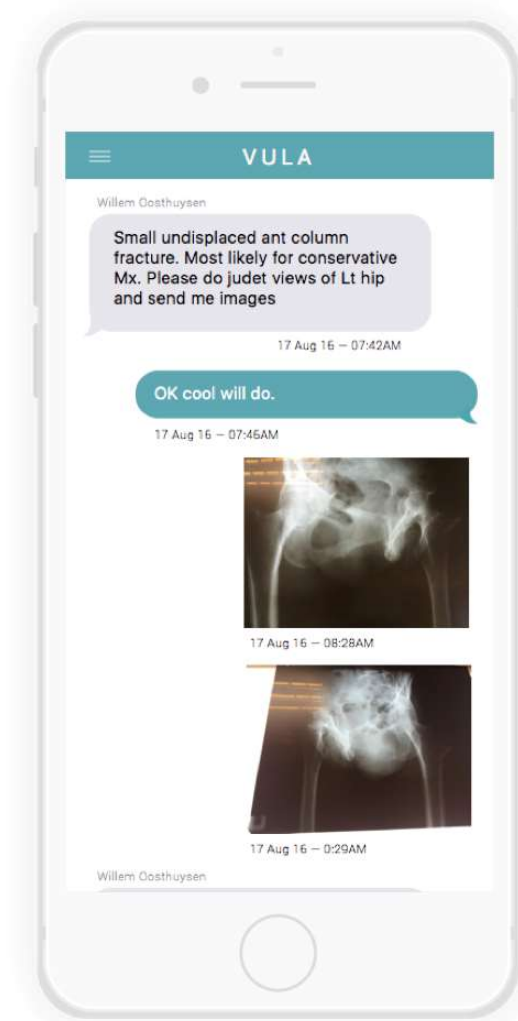
An app that makes it easy for health workers in remote rural areas to refer patients to specialists.



Vula is a free medical professional network app that makes it easy for primary healthcare workers to connect to specialists.





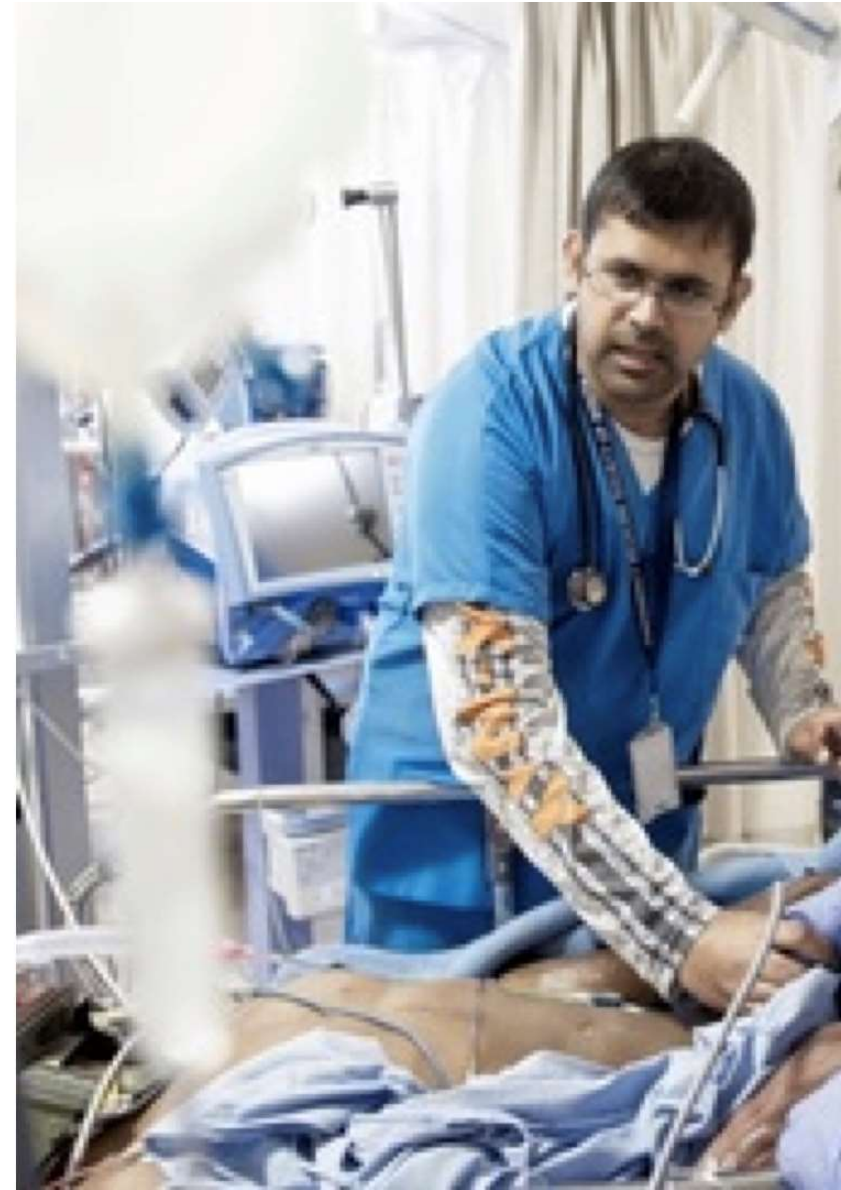

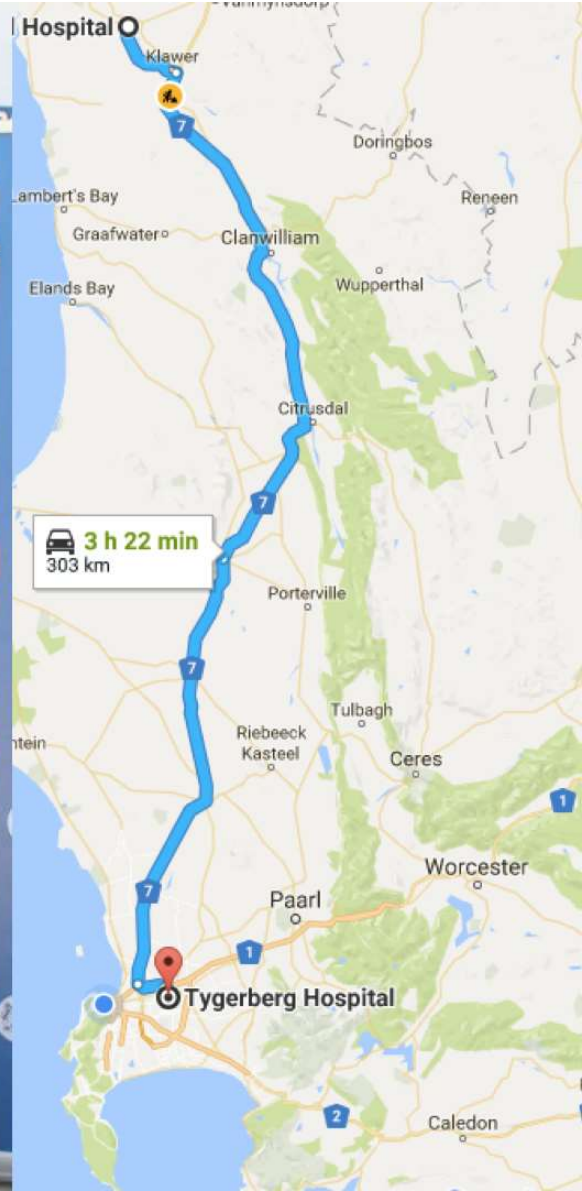

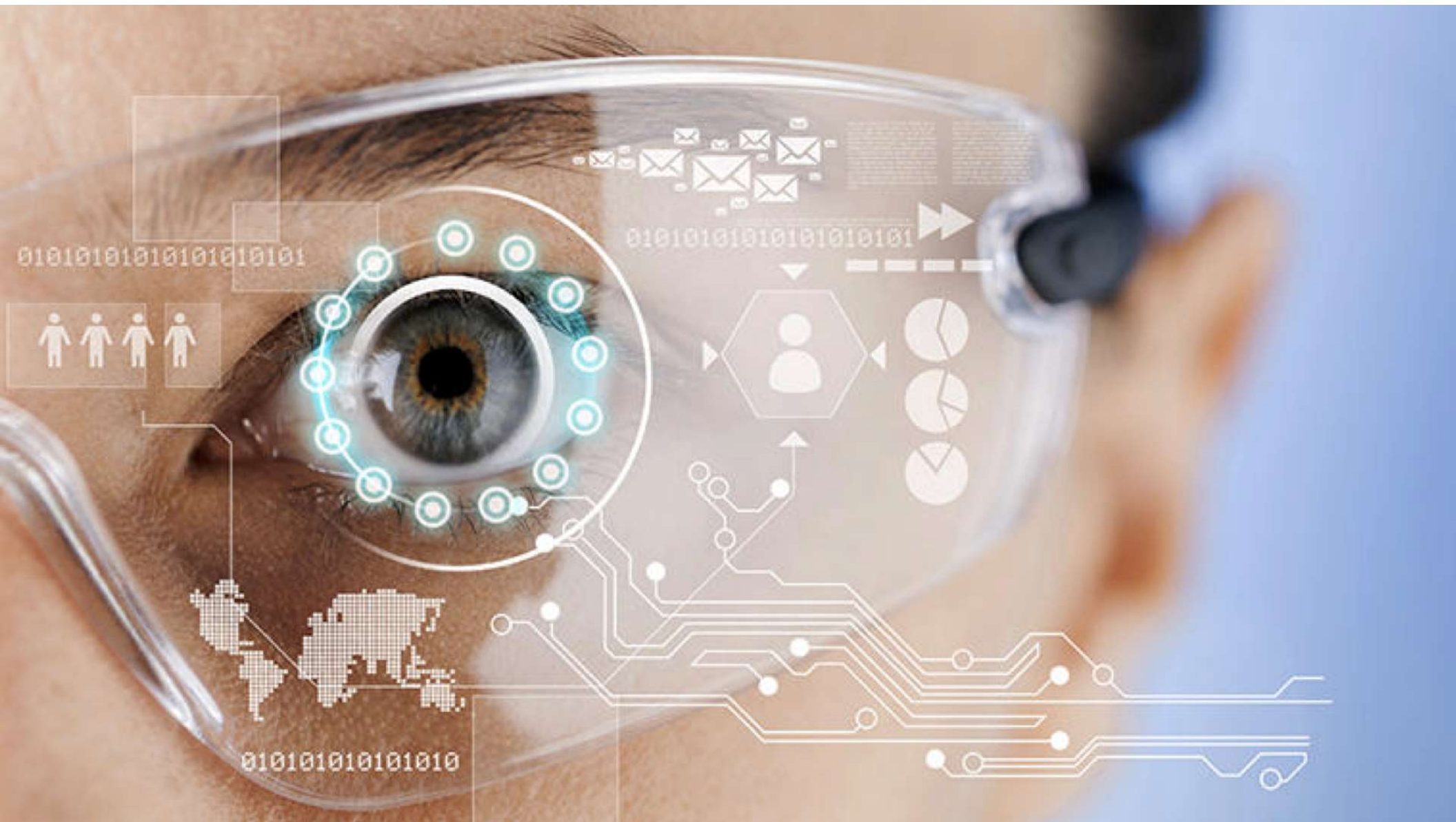
