- “A **Long term contract** (at least 10 yrs) between a **Government** entity and **private** party for the provision of public services and/or development of public infrastructure, in which responsibilities and rewards are **shared**”
- Benefits
  - Private capital
  - Long term Solution

  - Inflexibility

Four main roles

## 1. Policy Formulation

- To define long-term vision and strategy
- To secure high level political support



## 2. Legal and Regulatory Framework

- Clear legal basis
- Procumbent rules



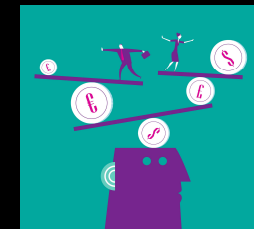
## 3. Institutional Arrangements
